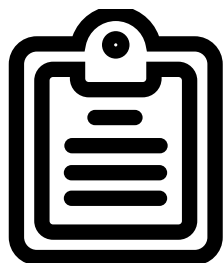

Course Registration

OPENED JUNE 1

If you have paid your confirmation deposit, begin registering for classes. Since registration is now open to all incoming students, it is to your advantage to register for classes as soon as possible, especially for those key prerequisite classes that others in your major will be trying to get into as well.

TO SEU

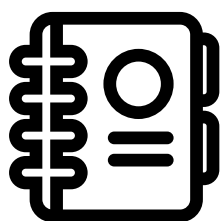
Request official transcripts for AP, IB, AICE, and Dual Enrollment be sent to SEU. Even if your dual enrollment credits are listed on your high school transcript, an official collegiate transcript is required from the university that issued the credits.
